# Key messages

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- Independent reading is a high priority
- Rigorous assessment (of phonics, fluency and comprehension) and related intervention allow support where required

# Reading in Reception & Y1

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- The book for practice matches the sounds of our phonics scheme to ensure decoding is embedded

# Reading in Y2-Y6

Whole-class reading instruction

Three reading structures, used flexibly in different proportions to meet needs in different year groups and classes:

Extended read Fluency read Close read

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- <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> reading, <sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> discussion

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- Questions and discussion <u>at end</u> to establish meaning

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- Meaning established <u>and</u> analysed
- 1/3 reading, 2/3 discussion

# Extended read Fluency read Close read

Different proportions of each type of reading sessions as children progress

Year 2	fluency	extended	fluency	extended	fluency
Year 3	fluency	extended	fluency	extended	close
Year 4	fluency	extended	fluency	extended	close
Year 5	extended	close	fluency	extended	close
Year 6	extended	close	extended	close	extended

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  - integrated with curriculum

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- Independent reading sessions in Y4-Y6 develop positive reading habits
