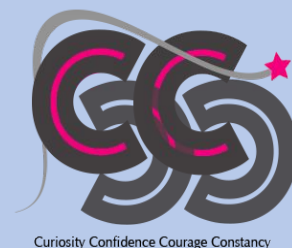

During the building work for the two new classrooms our Head Boy, Head Girl and Prefects created a time capsule that is situated in the back wall of Parks classroom and the Diner.

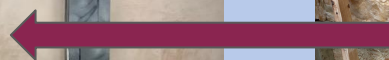
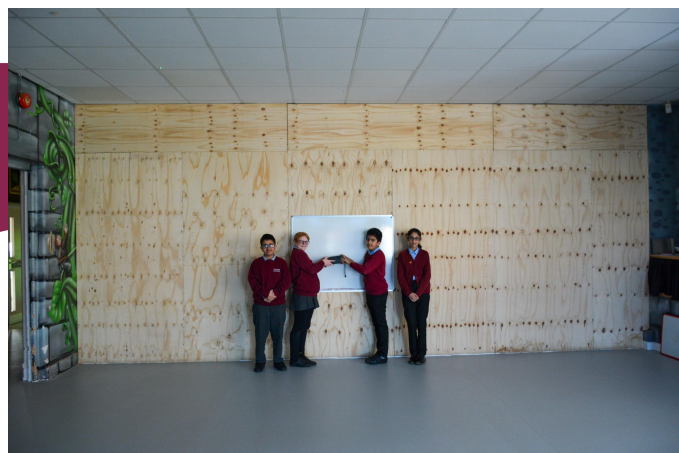
