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Key Person

During your child's time in the Foundation Stage class it is a requirement in the EYFS statutory framework that each child and family is assigned a 'Key Person'. If your child has previously attended a nursery/pre-school or another day care setting you may already be familiar with this practice.

A Key Person is a named member of staff who is assigned to your child to support their development and well-being. Their role is to help ensure that every child's care is tailored to meet their individual needs to help the child become familiar with the setting, offer a settled relationship for the child and build relationships. At Fulbridge Academy we feel that a key person will meet the needs of each child in their care and respond sensitively to their feelings, ideas and behaviour.

In our academy your child's key person is the class teacher, they have the responsibility for the educational and emotional well-being of your child. They will welcome your child, help them to 'settle in' and throughout your child's time in Foundation Stage will help and support your child to ensure they are cared for and their learning needs are met. You will also become familiar with the class teaching assistant, they too will support your child with their learning and development.
