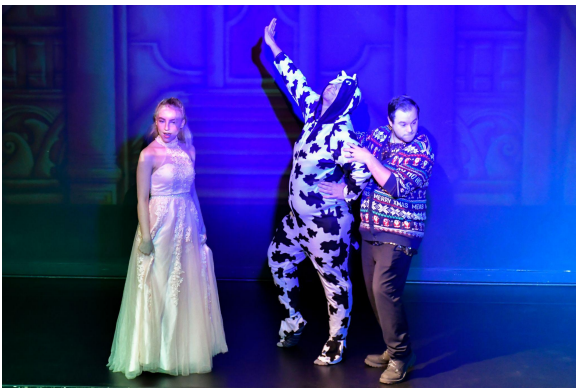
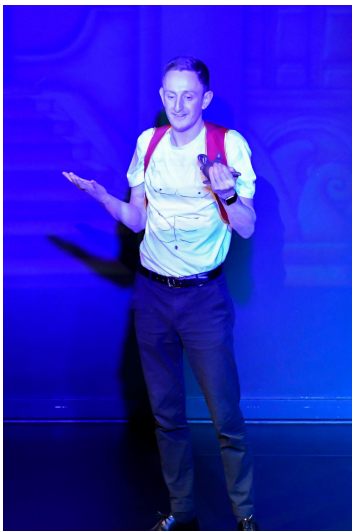
Christmas Dinner

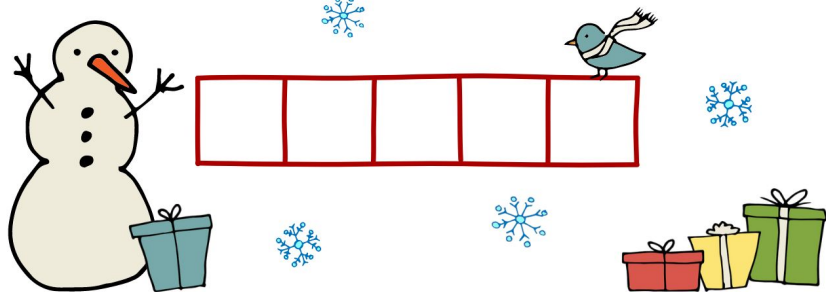
