At Fulbridge Academy, we believe that pupils, parents/carers, and school staff all play vital roles in helping children achieve their full potential- academically, creatively, physically, socially, and emotionally. We believe every child at Fulbridge Academy is capable of academic success at school and beyond; this agreement outlines how we will work together to ensure success.

Pupils Will:

- Show respect for others' cultures, beliefs, feelings, and values.
- Be responsible for their learning and behaviour both at school and at home.
- Ask for help when needed and always try their best.
- Be kind and behave respectfully toward everyone.
- Care for school property and the school environment.
- Follow school rules, including mobile phone use.
- Tell an adult if they are unhappy or worried.
- Take their reading book home and complete home learning on time.
- Use the values of Active Learning to help them develop as a person.

Parents/Carers Will:

- Ensure their child attends school every day, on time, and in full uniform (including PE kit).
- Ensure their child is collected from school every day, on time, and ensure only an approved adult collects.
- Provide a safe and supportive home environment for learning and emotional wellbeing.
- Inform the school of any issues affecting their child's learning or behaviour.
- Follow the school's behaviour, uniform and complaints policies.
- Treat staff and other community members with respect.
- Attend meetings and events, engaging positively in their child's learning journey.
- Keep contact and medical information up to date.
- Use the MCAS app and read all school communications.
- Provide a healthy, nut-free packed lunch if not using school meals.
- Ensure their child gets adequate sleep and avoids excessive screen use, especially at night.
- Ensure payments are made on-time.

The School Will:

- Provide a high-quality, inclusive education in a safe and stimulating environment.
- Teach children to respect and value all individuals, encouraging them to be active and responsible members of the community.
- Celebrate each child's achievements and support their development.
- Communicate regularly with parents/carers about children's progress and wellbeing.
- Provide information about policies, events, and learning opportunities via the MCAS app.
- We will ensure that all of the children in our care are safe at all times.
- We will enforce the Fulbridge Academy Behaviour Policy consistently and fairly; we will insist on high standards of behaviour and will hold students to account for their actions.
